

CEA Eligibility Requirements

The candidate for CEA certification must have (also see below for CEA in Training Requirements):

Education		Work Experience
A four-year degree in engineering or architecture OR Professional Engineer (PE) or Registered Architect (RA)	AND	At least 3 years of experience in energy auditing, energy management, facility management, or experience relating to facility management
A four-year non-engineering degree	AND	At least 4 years of experience in energy auditing, energy management, facility management, or experience relating to facility management
A two-year technical degree (Level 6 Irish NFQ in a relevant technical area)	AND	At least 5 years of experience in energy auditing, energy management, facility management, or experience relating to facility management
NONE		At least 10 years of experience in energy auditing, energy management, facility management, or experience relating to facility management

CEM Eligibility

Eligibility

The prerequisites to qualify for the certification process have been designed to take into account the possible diversity of education and practical experience an individual may have. However each CEM candidate must meet **one** of the following criteria:

Education		Experience
4-year degree in engineering or architecture OR Professional Engineer or Registered Architect	AND	3+ years of experience in energy engineering or energy management
4-year degree in technology, environmental science, physics, or earth science	AND	4+ years of experience in energy engineering or energy management
4-year degree in business (or related field)	AND	5+ years of experience in energy engineering or energy management
2-year energy management associate's degree	AND	6+ years of experience in energy engineering or energy management
2-year technical associate's degree (Level 6 Irish NFQ in a relevant technical area)	AND	8+ years of experience in energy engineering or energy management
NONE	AND	10+ years of experience in energy engineering or energy management

(Note: Letters of reference and verification of employment must be submitted.)

CMVP Eligibility

Each candidate must meet one of the following criteria in order to sit for the examination:

Education		Work Experience
4-year degree from an accredited university or college in science, engineering, architecture, business, law, finance, or related field	AND	3 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification
Registered Professional Engineer (PE) or Registered Architect (RA)	AND	3 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification
4-year non-technical degree from an accredited college or university in a field not specified above	AND	5 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification
2-year technical degree (Level 6 Irish NFQ in a relevant technical area)	AND	5 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification
None	AND	10 years of verified experience in energy or building or facility management, or measurement and verification
